Meeting Minutes

Meeting Called to Order: 6:07 pm

Old Business

- Previous meeting minutes were presented for review, approval, changes or additions. Minutes were recorded.
- ASB President Hoa Nguyen presented information on upcoming student events and fundraisers. Activities will include a Food Fair on January 22, ASB Hot Chocolate sale on January 28, a Talent Show on January 31, Valentine's Dance on February 15, and a movie night on February 7 pending district approval.
- Principal Roach reports that the week returning to school after the break has been good. There will be an Academic Excellence Assembly, by invitation, coming up. 52% of students made the honor roll.
- Treasurer Cohan presented the P & L report, the bank balance and the results of the Santa House fundraising. Santa House income total was \$5724.17 not including the \$3500 match from Marina Community Partners.
- President Graham discussed membership. We have 3 more new members for a total of 57. Only 15 are needed to be a functioning PTSA. With 580 students this is equal to about 10% membership. We will continue to accept membership applications as they come in, but will conclude the membership drive.
- There is no new fundraising planned for the rest of the year.
- Teacher appreciation breakfast set for January 29 at 7 AM. Planned menu – Oatmeal bar. VP Ways and Means Graham will send out text requests for individual items needed for the breakfast.



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- Teachers won the membership drive and those who joined PTSA will receive personalized coffee mugs to go with the Keurig machine that will be purchased as a PTSA gift to the staff of Marina High School.
- Options for the school sign (PTSA gift to the school) were discussed. Principal Roach will ask for ASB feedback, to come up with some creative ideas for what design they would like.
- Jesse Tamayo is in full charge of the senior trip. For the Sober Grad night party, we have a DJ already lined up and will request the services of the City of Marina, the Marina Lyons club and individuals for food booths as volunteers for the event which will run from 9 pm to 5 am.
- The Santa House did not get as many volunteers as were expected. It is most busy in the 2 weekends prior to Christmas, so for next year we will focus just in that timeframe to maximize volunteer services.

New Business

- President Graham discussed a re- focus for the PTSA
- PTSA will focus on less effort activities
- We will drop the PTSA membership requirement for events
- PTSA will plan on 2 events per year
- We will buy the Keurig machine and request donations to supply it for the teachers
- 6 months until Sober Grad night event
