Old Business

- Teacher appreciation set for Wednesday, March 11, 2015 and will be a hot breakfast
- Last Teacher appreciation will be April 8, 2015 and will be a Mexican taco bar lunch.
- Principal Williams gave an update on upcoming school events
  - We have seven community members to attend the WASC visit on Sunday which will start with refreshments at 5pm in The Cove followed by a meeting at 5:30pm
  - High School exit exams are scheduled for March 17 and 18.
  - March 19 is Academic Excellence award night
  - March 21 will be the ribbon cutting ceremony for the new baseball field
  - Smarter Balance test will be given to the Juniors in April
- President Graham gave an update on finances
  - We could not submit the Pebble Beach grant until after the AT&T
  - We have not yet received the donation from the Marina Grange
  - Sober grad funds still about \$9000
- We will hold executive committee elections on April 6<sup>th</sup>
  - President Graham will send out a ballot before April 6<sup>th</sup>
  - The executive committee will be the nominations committee and we should send out emails to see if anyone is interested in serving on the executive committee next year
- VP Ways and Means Erica Graham gave an update on Grad night and Sober grad
  - Busses have been booked. We must send a request to the board 21 days prior to May 14<sup>th</sup>(April 24<sup>th</sup>)
  - Fundraising packages have been handed out. Fundraising is due March 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Currently 19 students signed up for the trip
  - Scholarships are available, but students must make a good faith effort to fundraise in order to receive a scholarship
  - Sober Grad venue, photo booth, taco truck, and Dj Mix and Spin have been confirmed
  - Inflatables will cost more this year, as there is a \$2500 minimum
  - We are still looking for a tattoo artist
  - Illusionist/hypnotist is booked but we will need to provide a hotel room. Possibly donated.
